SOLO PROGRAM

SCCA Solo is a fun, inexpensive and safe way of testing your driving ability and car performance. Solo events are a form of automotive competition in which one car at a time negotiates a prescribed course in the shortest possible time. The events are open to anyone with almost any vehicle that is not an SUV or 4x4 truck. The only requirements to compete are a valid state driver's license and a car which will pass a safety technical inspection. Drivers compete in numerous car classes for stock street cars, modified street cars, race prepared cars and modified race cars. Car classing will be assisted at the school.

THE LEARNING CURVE – Solo New Drivers School

Chicago Region Solo driver's school is an excellent way to learn about and become involved in Solo events. It is a two-part school that consists of a classroom session and a day and a half of in car instruction. Instruction will be provided by experienced, award winning drivers (many with National Championship credentials). Because the entry is limited to only 100 students, there will be a very favorable student/teacher ratio allowing for maximum driving time and personal instruction. The school is for novice drivers with less than one year or no solo experience. Students **must** attend both days. Loaner helmets are available.

GENERAL SOLO REGULATIONS

- 1) A valid driver's license and SCCA membership are required, you must show this at the event each day. All drivers under 18 must have a minor waiver form signed by both parents and written permission to drive the car.
- 2) Helmets (2000 or newer K, SA or M Snell rating) are required. Some loaners are available.
- 3) Seat belts are required in all cars and must be worn while on course.
- 4) All cars must have adequate muffler systems.
- 5) Alcoholic beverages & narcotics are strictly prohibited. Anyone under the influence will be disqualified from further participation without a refund.
- 6) Refunds will be issued upon request to the Registrar, up to the morning of the event. This may be done by phone or email.
