## 2014 Chicago Region Club Racing/PDX Volunteer Recognition Program

Chicago Region is pleased to announce the continued support of the Region's Volunteer Recognition Program. This recognition program is open to all volunteers regardless of region of record and is financially supported by the Chicago Region Board of Directors. This program is separate from and in addition to any other National or local volunteer incentive or reward programs. The program has operated for over 7 years and counting.

- 1. This program applies to the following Chicago Region events: ALMS-TUDOR, PDX track days, the Chicago Region Kettle Moraine and Fall Sprints Divisional race weekends, and the CenDiv club racing Driver's School/Divisional race weekend.
- 2. The following are eligible Chicago Region Specialties: Race Chairman, Registration, Grid & Pit, Steward, Tech, Flagging & Communications, Radio Tech, Sound Control, Starter, Rescue, Course Marshal, Paddock, Timing & Scoring and all PDX event volunteers and Instructors.
- 3. This program is open to any volunteer, provided they are SCCA Members from any Region (including Temporary Memberships for the days worked\*). Paid or compensated staff are excluded from this program.
- 4. Volunteers earn credits for completing specific volunteer days in a Specialty. Combining days of more than one Specialty worked simultaneously is not allowed. The value of each credit is \$10.00.
- 5. Verification of days worked is at the discretion of the Region. Volunteers may be asked to have the Specialty Chief, Race Chairman or Regional Executive confirm or sign off for days worked.
- 6. A "day worked" is defined as working more than 90% of the available hours within a single day per the requirements of that Specialty.
- 7. <u>It is the volunteer's responsibility to submit their completed credit submission form to the Region.</u> <u>Forms must be received by the deadline date below.</u> <u>Late submissions cannot be accepted</u>. Completed forms may be mailed or faxed to the Club Office.
- 8. Chicago Region will issue payment of up to \$60.00 maximum to each volunteer.
- 9. **Payments will be sent after December 16, 2014.** The Chicago Region Board of Directors has sole authority to approve credit submissions and reserves the right to accept or reject any submissions.

<sup>\*</sup> Temporary membership participants in this incentive program who at time of submission are NOT full, regular members will only receive credit toward a regular membership fee. The completed regular membership form must accompany the submitted volunteer incentive form with any remaining balance due for the membership. The membership will be processed and submitted by Chicago Region.
