2012 Chicago Region Club Racing Volunteer Recognition Program

CR is pleased to announce the continued support of the Worker Recognition Program. This recognition program is open to all volunteers regardless to region of record and is financially supported by the Chicago Region Board of Directors. This program has operated for over 6 years and counting.

1. This program applies only to the following Chicago Region events; ALMS, all PDX's, the Chicago Region Kettle Moraine Regional and Fall Sprints weekends.
2. The following are the available Chicago Region Specialties: Race Chairman, Registration, Grid & Pit, Steward, Tech Inspection, Flagging & Communications, Guest Services / Driver Information, Radio Tech, Sound Control, Starter, Rescue, Course Marshal, Paddock, Timing & Scoring and all PDX volunteers.
3. This program is open to any volunteer, including PDX volunteers and instructors, provided they are SCCA Members, (to include temporary memberships*) from any Region.
4. Workers earn credits after completing specific volunteer days of a Specialty. Combining days of more than one Specialty worked simultaneously is not allowed. The value of each credit is \$10.00.
5. A "day" is defined as working more than 90% of the available hours within a single day per the requirements of that specialty.
6. Each worker must have the designated Chief of that Specialty sign off on the attached credit submission card for each day of a weekend. Specialty Chiefs will have either the Race Chairman or Regional Executive sign off on their credit submission card.
7. **It is the workers responsibility to submit their completed credit submission card to the Region. Cards must be received by the region by November 16, 2012. Late submissions will not be accepted** (see address on card, below). Completed cards may be mailed or will be accepted at the track after the final checkered flag of the final race weekend of the season. Paid or compensated staff is excluded from this program.
8. Chicago Region will issue you up to \$60.00 in credit for each worker qualifying based on selecting one of the **five** following option plans. If the worker is part of a Family or Spouse Membership, a maximum of \$90.00 will be credited to the Membership if submissions are received from more than one worker within the Family or Spouse Membership.
9. Credits will be sent to the member directly in the workers name **only after November 16, 2012**. The Chicago Region Board of Directors will address any questions and will review all credit submissions and reserves the right to reject any submissions it deems necessary.

**Temporary membership participants in the incentive program who at time of submission are not regular members will only receive the benefits towards a regular membership. The completed regular membership form must accompany the submitted volunteer incentive form with any remaining balance due and the membership will be processed and submitted by Chicago Region.*
