Check your Helmets

As of January 1, 2022, all 2005-rated helmets from Snell and SFI (SA2005, M2005 or K2005; SFI 31.1/2005 or 41.1.2005 for example) as well as BSI are no longer allowed in SCCA activities — that includes Solo, RallyCross, Time Trials and Track Events. For the Road Racing program, SA2010 and FIA 8860-2004-certified helmets have also reached the end of their eligibility.

George Laws Recipient of the SCCA Member of Excellence Award By Steven Laske

The Member of Excellence award was presented at the 2022 SCCA Convention which was again held virtually. This award is presented to a member/volunteer who shows the greatest commitment to SCCA Motorsports activities. The recipient can be involved in Solo, Rally, Club Racing, Time Trials and/or Track Events. This person should personify the SCCA volunteer who gives of his/her time and effort to helping organize, work in a specialty or any volunteer role necessary to a motorsports event. To be selected, the member must have rendered long-term service working

SCCA events or activities for a five-year minimum. The recipient cannot be a paid SCCA staff member, current Board of Directors member or any member who is a paid consultant to SCCA.

The Member of Excellence award is presented annually from nominations from the membership, and includes a trip to any motorsports event, anywhere in the world, through a generous grant from an anonymous member. This year, Chicago Region member George W. Laws Jr. was the recipient of this prestigious award.

Chairman of the SCCA Board of Directors, and fellow Chicago Region member, Peter Jankovskis had the honor to call George to inform him of his award. Jankovskis said "George was speechless, after hearing the news." Allowing the surprise of the call to settle in Laws said "A myriad of thoughts and words filled my head – honored, proud and energized among them... To the Board of Directors and everyone with me along the way who helps make the SCCA so successful, two words: thank you."

As are so many of our members, George is involved in many areas within the club. He is Chairman of the Competition Committee, and as comp chair is at every road race helping to oversee the daily operations of those events, he is also Safety Car Admin for the Region. He serves as Treasurer of the Track Event / Time Trials Committee and attend all of these events as well. George is also a member of the Activities Committee, and last but certainly not least he serves the Region as our Club Office Manager. George you were very kind to recognize all those that work with and assist you to ensure SCCA is successful. With that the Chicago Region, its Board of Directors and membership say Thank You to you for all that you do.

Kevin Coulter Recipient of the SCCA David Morrell Award By Steven Laske

The David Morrell Award is presented to recognize an active Steward in the Stewards Program who has exhibited outstanding performance and dedication to the sport and its highest principles. The recipient is selected by the Chairman of the Stewards and the Executive Stewards. Kevin Coulter was named the 41st recipient of The David Morrell Award at this year's convention.

Kevin become a National Steward in 2009 and has been a part of the Stewards staff at the Runoffs since that time. Kevin has also served the Chicago Region as Chief Steward of the Chicago Region June Sprints® for the past seven years. In 2015 he was selected to be an Executive Steward for the Central Division and since 2018 has been the Executive Steward's liaison on the Stewards Training and Development Committee. He was awarded the Steward Worker of the Year in 2017 at the Runoffs. Kevin currently serves as one of the Hoosier Super Tour Clerks of the Course, also he has served as the Clerk of the Course for the Runoffs since 2020.

To add to the distinctiveness of this award presented to Kevin. Like Kevin, Dave Morrell was a Chicago Region member and steward. For one to meet the values and principles of this award named for Dave is a great achievement. Doing so as a member of David's beloved Chicago Region with that same dedication and devotion is an even greater achievement. From the Chicago Region, congratulations Kevin, well done.



Bob Stone

Passed Away January 25, 2022



The racing community has lost a devoted friend and fan. The Chicago Region and the Sports Car Club of America have lost a treasure. Bob Stone, passed away on January 25, 2022, at the age of 84.

Bob joined SCCA as a young man in the 1950s in Ohio eventually moving to the Chicago area and becoming a member of the Chicago Region. His vocation was in marketing and while working for Team Penske and then for Newman Haas Racing he honed his craft. He was a people person and had friends and contacts throughout the sport of motor racing.

Bob was an advocate for the SCCA volunteer worker, always thinking of them and wanting nothing but the best for them. In 2017 Chicago Region Director Bob Stone, facilitated an agreement with American Honda Motors to provide an opportunity for one lucky club member/volunteer to be a passenger in the Indy Racing Experience two seat Indy car for one lap of Road America.

Bob served the Chicago Region in many ways, He was a member of the Region's Board of Directors for a total of twelve years, and a member of the Competition Committee for many more years. He was responsible for establishing the driver awards program for the June Sprints. He was also a member of the Activities Committee (i.e. The FUN Committee) since its inception in 2016 with its focus on the membership and social activities.

As a member of the Activities Committee, Bob would reach out to many of his friends and contacts in the sport for the Region's membership meetings programs. In early 2020 Bob arranged for Doug Fehan, then Chevrolet Corvette Racing Program Manager to speak about the racing program and the new Corvette C8 race cars. Bob took this one step further and facilitated having a brand new C8 Corvette on display for the meeting. Again, another example of his devotion to the club and its members.

In recognition of his many years of participation and support of the Chicago Region, Bob was a recipient of the Founders Award in 2015. In 2019 Bob received the "RE" Recognition Award for his support of the Region's racing program. Bob loved the sport, the people, and the friendships he gained over the years. He was a true treasure and will definitely be missed.



In 1956 /57 Sid was editor of Piston Patter the clubs newsletter and brought the magazine to a new design level. This masthead was initially used on April 1951 with the printing of the first Piston Patter. When was this masthead last used?
