The Region helped sponsor and participated in the South Elgin High School 16th Annual Auto Show. The event took place at the school on Saturday, May 14th. The show attracted over 150 entries and a large number of visitors. The Region's display featured Pete LeSueur's Formula Continental Van Diemen race car. It drew much attention and spectators to our SCCA canopy and table. Other cars in the display included a 2010 Porsche 911 (George Laws), a 1985 Porsche 911 Carrera (Bob and Carolyn Malm) and a beautifully restored 1936 GMC pickup truck with a V-8 engine and three-deuce setup (Claire and Peg Ball).

Proceeds from the show help offset costs of the school's automotive program including the student engine tear down team which competes nationally.

The Auto Show provided the Region the opportunity to reach out to younger enthusiasts and promote the Club. A "just off the press" brochure was distributed, highlighting the Region's "having fun with cars" activities and the advantages of Club membership.
