Chicago Region's Annual Business Meeting

On November 16th we held our Annual Business Meeting in accordance with the Region's By-Laws. The annual meeting serves two purposes. First is the ceremonial installation of the new board of directors as nominated by the independent nomination committee. The second is reports from the Board, Treasurer and the various committees that planned and supported the various events this year. The committees reported that they executed the plans they created for the year, but not without some financial challenges.

The best summary came from Ed Locke's treasurer report. He reported that due to inflationary pressure and unbudgeted worker give aways road racing missed their planned budget but did not lose money for the year. Track Events suffered from less track availability and poor weather conditions. The result was a missed budget but not a loss. Solo, Tours, and Activity committees reported that they made their budgets.

The region overall will have a financial loss for the year due to the overheads the Region needs to support. Fortunately, we had enough saved from previous years to cover the short fall. In all, the Region remains financially healthy and poised to capitalize on a more stable economy in the future.

The South Elgin High school car show was one of our events, we support the schools automotive technical training program while promoting the clubs racing and autocross programs.

We plan to host eight Autocross points events and The Learning Curve in 2023. We plan to host an Evolution Performance Driving School in 2023. We will host a Street Survival School in 2023.


