Board of Directors Nomination Committee Process

The Committee will consist of 3 members appointed by the Board of Directors and 4 members nominated by the Board of Directors. What's the difference between being appointed and nominated? Appointed members of the committee cannot be challenged by the general membership. However, according to our by-laws the nominated members can be challenged by the general membership. The membership can submit an alternate slate of 4 nominees with a petition, with 260 membership signatures (20% of the active membership) to the Board of Directors Secretary by June 20. If an alternate slate is presented to the Secretary, then the membership will vote on the eight nominees with the top four vote getters being appointed to the committee. This process gives the nomination committee voting majority to the membership and not the board of directors.

Club Racing's Driver of the Year

The Chicago Region Driver of the Year Award is presented to the driver who has achieved the best allround performance over the course of the club racing season. Chris Schaafsma was the 2022 winner. So drivers, if you are aspiring to be next year's driver of the year, here is how you gather points. First you must be a member of the Chicago Region and points are awarded by class. So, if you are a multi-class driver your points are awarded by class achievements.

First are the series championships, Cen/Div, Majors, and Super Tour. Second is the run-offs. Points are awarded for first, second and third in class. Points are also awarded for the first 5 places in class at the June Sprints. Triple-Crown® winners get bonus points.

Points are also awarded to class winners at any Major or Division race. Lastly participation points are awarded for attending the 3 Chicago Regional races.

Henry "Hank" Jaffe July 21, 1935 - March 19, 2023 57 Year Member



The racing community has lost a devoted Chicago Region member. Hank was actively involved in region activities for most of his life. Starting as a race car builder and driver of numerous cars and progressing to a race worker. Hank spent many years actively working numerous races as a corner worker and became a race steward in mid-1980s. He also served on the CenDiv competition committee from 1990 to 1996. In 2012, Hank was awarded the Chicago Region Founders Award for his dedicated service to the Region.

Road America Resurfacing Project

ELKHART LAKE, Wis., – November 3, 2022 – A ribbon cutting at America's National Park of Speed commemorated the completion of the long-anticipated replacement project of the racing surface that has not been overhauled since 1995. Milling and grinding the entire 4.048-mile racetrack, including the pit lane, began on October 3. Fine grading, a new base layer, and a new final surface asphalt layer followed in late October. Now the all-new race surface has the entire off-season to cure before the 2023 season.

The big news is that aside from the opportunity to make minor adjustments, the original configuration of the entire racetrack remained the same. Advanced Materials Services consultants, Walbec Group engineers, and their Northeast Asphalt team were mindful of the tracks' history and authentic character. Before milling off the old surface, the entire racecourse was surveyed to allow the engineers and Road America to review the track's unique characteristics and make decisions that guided the grade control process during each step of the repaving process. Over 7,000-grade control points were set to direct the grading and paving process to ensure that the track width, camber angles, and curbing locations were accurate within a tenth of an inch.

"Our goal was to put the track back exactly as we found it to maintain its distinct features and preserve the track's significance in the racing world," said Craig Donze, Engineering Manager for the Walbec

Group. "High-quality aggregates were locally sourced from Wisconsin, and the team used a highly polymerized asphalt mix to maximize durability. Multiple tests were performed throughout the project to ensure the surface would handle the weather and racing stresses. Teamwork from initial planning through construction resulted in a racing surface that will provide competitors and racing fans enjoyment for years to come."

Engineers and Road America worked collaboratively throughout the project to improve drainage around the property and upgrade features that cross beneath the racing surface before paving. This included increasing the size of culverts and running new conduits under the track to support the facility's events. Over 800 truckloads were removed during milling, with nearly the same number of trucks bringing in the new asphalt racing surface for paving. During the project, two paving machines ran in an echelon (side-by-side) pattern to minimize the center seam visibility and maintain a consistent density.



"This was a massive endeavor, and we are extremely excited to have a new racetrack for competitors and fans to enjoy," said Mike Kertscher, Road America's President and General Manager. "The goal was to keep it the same as our founder Clif Tufte envisioned, and we're certain we met that goal. We look forward to the future with this all-new track and pit lane, and we encourage everyone to get their season passes, tickets, and camping for what we anticipate will be an incredible season in 2023."


Chicago Region March Meeting March 22, 2023

Solo School



The Learning Curve is a bit different than the average autocross event. The goal with this 2-Day Instructional Course is to get folks who are new to racing to be more comfortable with the process and nuances so they can be more focused on racing and having fun while at the race. An autocross can be a stressful day if you aren't prepared, and by the end of this weekend you will be ready for pretty much anything that could come your way on race day.

Learn how to race your car on a closed race course with personal instruction. Autox or Solo racing is the sport of racing against the clock on a race course made of small orange traffic cones. The goal being to navigate the course in the shortest amount of time possible without knocking down any of the cones or deviating from the course which would be known as a DNF or did not finish. You race one at a time, this is not wheel to wheel racing. The best instructors in the area will give you one-on-one instruction in your car and get you up to speed! How to attack the day from the beginning to end. We will teach you the basics of the sport including how to prepare your car and yourself for the day and also how to work the course. What to expect the day of the event from registration through the trophy ceremony. No matter where you attend an Autocross event, you will be well prepared after having attended the Learning Curve.


At the end of October the contest committee will select the out standing photos which will then be judged for the winners. Contest winners will be announced at the November General Membership Meeting.
