Solo National Tour Hosted by the Chicago Region

On July 14th through the 16th the Chicago Region is hosting the Tire Rack SCCA Solo national Tour. We are pleased to be able to host this event as a part of our 75th anniversary celebration at our Solo hangout Route 66 Dragway.

The National Tour competition takes place over two days with a different course each day, just like Solo Nationals. Drivers get three runs on each course with their best time from each added together for the final class standings. Runs are timed to 1/1000th of a second and knocking a cone down means a penalty of 2 seconds added to that time. So, register if you want to compete or just come down to watch the action.

Jim, a two-time SCCA National Champion driver, purchased Lime Rock Park in 1964 from its builders and over the next decade first as owner and then as general manager, shepherded the facility's growth from near bankruptcy to internationally recognized motorsports venue

Following his tenure at Lime Rock Park, Jim worked with the SCCA's national office and for many years was president and general manager of Elkhart Lake's Road America. Jim was a good friend of the Chicago Region, and many of its members.

He will be missed.

Receives Prestigious Governor's Cup at the WeatherTech Chicago Region SCCA June Sprints®

Road America, – June 26, 2023 – Jonathan Laun, the former Chairman of the Board at Road America, was honored with the Governor's Cup at the WeatherTech Chicago Region SCCA June Sprints. This highly regarded award, presented annually at the June Sprints in collaboration with the Chicago Region SCCA, celebrates the dedication and passion of amateur racers, devoted volunteers, and motorsport enthusiasts who wholeheartedly contribute to the advancement of Road America and the sport.

Laun's unwavering commitment to Road America spans an incredible 44 years, making him the longest-serving member in the history of the board. Since his election in 1978, he has held numerous esteemed positions within the organization, including Treasurer and Vice President, before assuming the role of Chairman of the Board in 1990, which he held until 2018. Throughout his tenure, Laun's leadership and invaluable insights have been instrumental in shaping Road America's growth and prosperity.

Laun's association with Road America began during his college years, when he worked summers for Clif Tufte, the founder of Road America, in the 1960s. Since then, under Laun's astute stewardship, the track has undergone significant transformations, witnessing the implementation of substantial infrastructure improvements. The track's profits have consistently been reinvested. With the construction of numerous new buildings and the introduction of enhanced safety measures and track modifications, enhancing the experiences of fans and competitors alike, the track continues to prosper as America's National Park of Speed.

Solo Report

Chicago Region is hosting a Sports Car Club of America Solo National Championship Tour July 14th through the 16th at Rt66 Raceway. Over 140 racers from 18 states have signed up so far and registration is still open! Former Solo Chairman Mike Razny is in charge of course design and setup so expect a fast, fun and technical track! Friday will feature a Staring Line Drivers school for anyone new to the Solo National Tour format and an Evolution Advantage school for the more advanced racers.

Following the morning classes, we will host a Test and Tune course for approximately 4 hours to get your ride dialed in for the Champ Tour. Friday night will also host a welcome party for all in the early evening. Competition days are the 15th and 16th only, Friday is optional. If you have not already, get signed up today.



Chicago Region SCCA June Sprints® trophy, "It's not just another trophy"

Many of you participate in the road racing activities of the club and specifically the June Sprints. Many other club members have and share interests in other specialties within the club and never see or experience the road races. Of these two groups there is still a smaller group that see a Chicago Region SCCA June Sprints trophy. The June Sprints trophies are unique to the Sprints and we would like to share with you what they look like. The Sprints trophies are a hardwood plaque with engraved art work created for us by Jim Swintal. There are eight different trophy designs and they are in a rotation used once every eight years. For this year, the Region's 75th Anniversary, a special design was created providing a special trophy for the winners and subsequent trophy positions.



The design for this year shows four different race car groups from specific significant June Sprints. The first car a Ferrari from the 1956 Inaugural June Sprints. The second car a Formula B from the 25 Anniversary of Chicago Region, 1973 June Sprints. The third car a Spec Racer Ford from the 50 Anniversary of the Chicago Region, the 1998 June Sprints, and finally the GT-1 car representing this year, our 75 Anniversary, 2023 June Sprints. Everything is engraved on this trophy which is different from the other trophy designs where an engraved metal plaque indicating the race class and finish position is affixed to the trophy.

To win at the June Sprints and receive one of these trophies is special. This year we wanted the trophy to be more significant, to be different, "not just another trophy". Because it's the June Sprints, "It's not just another race".

The car show is held on the original site of the former Meadowdale Raceways in Carpentersville, IL. Although the 3.27 mile track with its famous Monza Wall no longer exists, sections of the circuit remain. The car show, along with the Region's display, will be positioned on what was the main straight.
