April General Membership Meeting**

The Chicago Region held its second general membership meeting of the year at the WeatherTech facility at 881 Remington Blvd. Bolingbrook IL. 60440 next store to the WeatherTech Factory Store. The meeting was called to order by "RE" Dave Tatge at 7pm and Dave conducted the Region's business at hand. Per the Region bylaws he reported on the 2026 Chicago Region Nominating Committee, explained the committee member selection and approval process, and then presented the names of the individuals appointed and nominated to the 2026 committee. Dave also spoke a bit about the upcoming competition season. He then introduced our host Cooper MacNeil and the new President of WeatherTech, Ryan Granger.

Ryan spoke first sharing with us some of what is going on at WeatherTech, and he spoke of how he was looking forward to participating in our Track Day events and eventually taking part in our road racing events. Then it was Cooper's time at the podium. Cooper had brought to the meeting location four of his past race cars, three BMW's of different race classes and competition levels, and one Porsche. to winning a race in one of the BMWs which was protested. That story sparked a reaction from one of the race stewards present at the meeting. Cooper also shared a story about a watch he won, how his father David was waiting and the bottom of the winner's podium stairs hand out for the watch. Cooper told his father he was going to keep the watch and promised him one in the future. Years later that day arrive and as Cooper came off the podium David was there waiting patiently. We would also like to thank Cooper and Ryan for the light bites/soda and water, the sandwiches were great and the cheese and cracker tray was fantastic, thank you Cooper and Ryan, and please pass our thanks to the staff.

The program concluded with a presentation about Chicago Region, its member's stories and capturing and preserving our history. "Back in August 1988 at Road America for the Kettle Moraine Regional Road Race, otherwise known (at that time) as the Chicken Regional (but that's another story). The Registration barn was all abuzz, the registrars were all excited and for good reason Tom Cruise was entered in the race. The fact that he was entered was exciting but it seems he hadn't completed his entry form and received a letter from the chief registrar. The letter in the inner circle or registrars meant just one thing, he was coming to registration. It was early Friday evening, registration was busy, and the weather was a bit cool so the overhead door was closed. This story teller was just standing outside registration, with my dog, talking to friends and entrants as they entered the building. Then there he was walking up to the building, wearing a dark, just a bit soiled one-piece coverall and his hair unkempt. No one noticed him as he walked into the building, he approached the counter took care of business and was gone, just like that. No scuttlebutt, no disruptions, he exited as quietly as he entered and disappeared into the paddock just like every other driver there that weekend."

April was full of Solo events. We started out April 11 & 12 with our annual Learning Curve autocross school, which included classroom instruction, in-car coaching, and a full day of runs on Saturday. Then on Sunday, a full practice autocross event was held. The weekend gave students the chance to learn, improve, and gain valuable seat time ahead of the season. We had 79 students and workers participate – thank you to all the volunteers that made this another big success.

Prior to Event 1, we held a Test n Tune on Saturday April 25. We hit the attendance cap of 80 drivers, and even with a big crowd things went very smoothly. Drivers were able to fine tune their set ups, scrub in new tires, give a Viking funeral to old tires, and knock the rust off from the winter. Thank you to everyone for coming out and playing nice. Then on Sunday April 26 we officially kicked off the 2026 season points events. Again we hit the cap of entries and actually allowed a few extra people to participate. Final count was 177 timed drivers which included 19 novices. We were able to get a full 6 runs in for all the drivers and wrapped up just about 5pm. A long day for sure, but a good one and an awesome start to this year of competition. Many class battles came down to final runs and every tenth, hundredth, or even thousandth of a second mattered.

By the time you read this Event 2 will have occurred on May 3. The Solo Committee is working diligently on our next event after that, which will be the Chicago Challenge on June 13 and 14. This 2-day event will be separate from the season points events and have some fun competitive elements different from your normal autocross event, as well as some exciting social activities. More news on all of that to come shortly.
